





SS Great Britain Experience

In 1843 the first iron steam ship with a screw propeller to sail the Atlantic was launched in Bristol, designed by Isambard Kingdom Brunel. 137 years later, after a varied career in the open seas, she was rescued from where she lay, abandoned, in the Falkland Islands, and towed home. She returned up the Avon Gorge and under Brunel's Clifton Suspension Bridge, to be lovingly restored in the Great Western Dock. Explore the ship's history and experience the sights, sounds and smells of life on board from top to bottom.

CLIFTON VILLAGE AND LIDO

An intimate Victorian Lido in the heart of Clifton Village. Enjoy a swim and sauna or a full spa package, then relax by the pool over coffee and cakes. Clifton Village is also home to boutique independent shops, specialist food and antiques, and a coffee shop culture much loved by its local residents. Or get your bearings for the weekend ahead from Clifton Observatory's Camera Obscura.

Friday Afternoon

Bristol Ferries Harbour Tour – from the hotel, walk down the ‘zig zags’ to the river at The Pump House, Hotwells, or join the ferry from the city centre on Lewinsmead. The tour lasts approx. 40 minutes. A longer tour, taking in Temple Meads, lasts 80 minutes.

Bristol Lido – a beautiful Victorian Lido in the heart of Clifton. Public swimming with access to the sauna, steam room and hot tub is from 1pm-4pm on Friday; no bookings, places allocated on a first come, first served basis, price £20.
